
## **Recommended Use:**

Each lot of this antibody is quality control tested by flow cytometric analysis. The amount of the reagent is suggested to be used 5  $\mu$ L of antibody per test (million cells in 100  $\mu$ L staining volume or per 100  $\mu$ L of whole blood). Please check your vial before the experiment. Since applications vary, the appropriate dilutions must be determined for individual use.

## Data:

Human peripheral blood monocytes are stained with Anrti-Human CD11c Monoclonal Antibody(AF647 Conjuaged)(filled gray histogram). Unstained monocytes (empty black histogram) are used as control.
